

## AEP Ohio - ESP V Customer Portal Implementation

### INTERRUPTIBLE POWER (IRP) TARIFF

May 31, 2024	Annually beginning on May 31, 2024, IRP-L and IRP-E customers (including reasonable arrangement participants) may reset their firm service levels.
June 1, 2024	Effective June 1, New credit will be applied to current participants.
May 31, 2024 – June 30, 2024	Open queue at Noon E.S.T. on May 31 (emails received prior to that time will be rejected) for new and existing expanded participation of 55 MW (30 MW of which is reserved for OMAEG). Email form to the ESP Portal: ESP_Portal_admins@aep.com.
July 1, 2024	Deadline for each IRP current or eligible subscriber to provide the Company with a written notice of each customer’s election whether to participate in the program for the entire ESP term. To enroll, the sponsoring customer groups must use Company provided form to be completed by sponsoring customer group on behalf of each member and send via email. A single email must be used for enrollment under the sponsoring customer group’s overall allocation cap (48 MW for OEG, 82 MW for OELC and 60 MW for OMAEG), attaching all the individual completed customer forms to that email; these emails may be sent any time before June 30 and presumably after interested customer members have clarity on whether they were accepted into the 25 MW expansion. Separate emails must be used for each customer attempting to enroll for part of the additional 25 MW program expansion – these emails should be sent soon after the queue opens and will be tagged in the queue for the first come, first served procedure. Once the 25 MW expansion cap is reached, the Company will notify all applicants of their status under the expansion; if the cap is not reached by June 10, the Company will advise the sponsoring customer groups of that status.
July 1, 2024	Expanded interruptible load will be included in rates.
On or before July 1, 2024	Will notify Customers that are enrolled and work to execute an addendum.

*Note: Reasonable Arrangement customers will not count toward the program’s cap and do not need to enroll using the above process for the MW covered through their approved reasonable arrangement.*

### BASIC TRANSMISSION COST RIDER (BTCR) 1 CP PILOT

July 1, 2024	Deadline for each customer that was eligible to participate in the Pilot BTCR program during ESP IV (including reasonable arrangement participants) to provide the Company with a written notice of its election within 30 days of the ESP term commencement (i.e., by July 1, 2024) whether to participate in the BTCR 1CP Pilot program for the entire ESP term. Each sponsoring customer group must complete the form on behalf of its members and email the form to aepohiobtcr1cpportal@aep.com.
December 1-7	Portal available for 20 MW (20% of 100MW increase) will be set aside for customers with a monthly billing demand of 10 MW or less (See the next slide).
December 8-31	Portal available for remaining increased participation cap.
No later than February 1, 2026	Every eligible participant that elects to participate in the program will secure its status as a participant for the full term, subject to the ability to exit the program at the end of the second year of the ESP term by giving written notice to the Company at least sixty (60) days prior to the end of the second program year. Only applicable for the third and fourth years of the program.

### BTCR 1 CP Pilot Portal

C&I Customer	AEP Ohio C&I Customer will log into their account using existing credentials from the AEP Ohio website. They will Navigate to the ESP V AEP Ohio webpage.
Sponsor	Sponsors will create a log-in for the ESP Portal. Sponsor will need customer account number to register them to the queue.

*Note: If there are duplicative requests for the same account by a customer and sponsor, the Company will take the first request in order and reject the second request.*
