**Obtaining Usage Data and Pre-Enrollment Data**

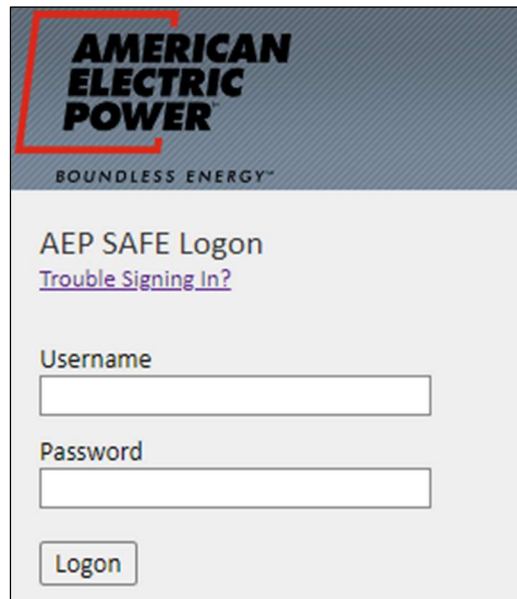
# BUSINESS PARTNER PORTAL

The purpose of this documentation is to provide the end user with instructions on how to utilize the AEP Ohio Business Partner Portal. Currently a user will be able to download AEP Ohio pre-enrollment list text files, customer's 12 months of historical cumulative data, and customer's interval data (if applicable) with an appropriate AEP Letter of Authorization (LOA) from the portal. ## AEP Ohio Business Partner Portal

You must have “CRES Broker” or “CRES User,” role in BOLT and BPP in order to view/download customer historical usage. You can check with your specific CRES Broker for access, or contact [OhioChoiceOperation@aep.com](mailto:OhioChoiceOperation@aep.com) for details.

2. **Pre-Enrollment Data** – Click the “BPP Reports” link under the “Usage Data/Reports” header on the top to obtain the AEP Ohio Pre-Enrollment files.

This page (BPP Reports) will give you access to download the pre-enrollment list data text files for AEP Ohio’s Columbus Southern Power (CSP) and Ohio Power (OP) rate jurisdictions. The Excel format file will also be included. All three can be downloaded in one zip file. *\*Note due to the size of the files, download time may vary.*

- Check the Box at the bottom, “By clicking, the party seeking the customer information associated with this inquiry hereby certifies that it is entitled to such information pursuant to applicable law”.
- Click on “Download” to obtain the files.

Pre-Enrollment List - All eligible accounts in the AEP Ohio service territory – Ohio Power and Columbus Southern Power  
Sync List - Allows CRES Provider to download a list of all customers with current liability  
Customer Payment Arrangement List (CPA) - Cumulative list of all customers who have entered into a payment arrangement with AEP Ohio

- Historical Usage Data** – Click on “Download Data” link under the “Usage Data/Reports” header on the top of the screen to obtain customer attributes/historical cumulative data.

This will bring you to the following screen:

View / Download Cumulative and Interval Data.

- Monthly cumulative data is provided for up to 12 months. AMI Interval data, in 15-minute usage increments, is provided up to 24 months.
- Actual customer data available may be less.
- All data presented is billed quality data and could be up to 30 days old.
- Cumulative data and customer attributes are viewable on a separate detailed screen by clicking the SDI. Cumulative data is also available for download.
- Interval data is only available for download.

- 4. **Downloading Historical Usage (Cumulative or Interval)** – Once SDI number has been searched, the options for downloading cumulative and interval (if applicable) will appear.

**CUMULATIVE:**

Cumulative bubble will already default to be selected.

- Check the Box at the bottom, “By clicking, the party seeking the customer information associated with the inquiry hereby certifies that it is entitled to such information pursuant to applicable law, and that the party seeking the information has obtained the consent of the customer to acquire such information from American Electric Power (AEP).”
- Click on “Download” to obtain the files.

**INTERVAL:**

Interval option will be grayed out if BPP does not have a valid LOA on file for that SDI number and CRES Provider combination.

With a valid LOA on file for your SDI number and CRES Provider, the Interval option (if applicable) will be available.

Check the Box at the bottom, "By clicking, the party seeking the customer information associated with the inquiry hereby certifies that it is entitled to such information pursuant to applicable law, and that the party seeking the information has obtained the consent of the customer to acquire such information from American Electric Power (AEP)."

Click on "Download" to obtain the files.

Select cumulative or interval data for the download. Data is returned in .csv format.

**Download**

You will be prompted to Open/Save/Cancel. \*Pop up will differ based on Internet Browser.



Because Microsoft Excel will read the contents as "general," if you open the file with Excel as the default program for CSV files, SDIs will be presented in scientific notation. Importing data in "general" format will convert all numeric values to numbers. It's highly advised that you save the file locally first and then import into Excel as text. Both CSP & OP SDIs are accompanied with leading zeroes as a prefix. These should be imported as text to remain intact.
